






Erasmus+ project **GAME-ED**: Development of creativity skills by game-based learning methods in adult education officially started on 1<sup>st</sup> of March 2021, so we are almost halfway through the project. It's time to take a look at its progress!

## What is GAME-ED main objective?

The main objective of the project is to improve the quality of teaching-learning methods used to build and develop the skills of creativity at adult learners by introducing a game-based approach to learning based on originally elaborated studies, guidelines, methodologies, and an educational game for adult educators, and overall to promote game-based learning in adult education.

## After Kick-off meeting

After the kick-off meeting, that was held online on 30<sup>th</sup> of March 2021, partners were working on Intellectual outputs and in one year they finished the work on three of them.

-  IO1 - Collection of methods on building creativity skills in adult education (already published on the website of the project).
-  IO2 – Collection of best practices of game-based learning to build key competences in adult education.
-  IO3 – Methodology for the selection of game mechanics, suitable for creativity development.

## What's next?

In the next phase of the project, that is in IO4, partners will create a board game which will help the users developing their creativity skills.

In the last Intellectual output, IO5, we will create guidelines for the identification of board games appropriate for creativity development.
